Re: Headlice

This is an ongoing problem for some families and causes huge discomfort for the children who have become infected. **To address the current problem we are asking that every single child in the family, whether in school or not, be checked this weekend and treated accordingly** (Adults also need to be checked). It is essential that all families co-operate otherwise we will have children constantly being re-infected despite the best efforts of their parents.

Children come into contact with headlice in areas other than the school. When young children are playing with others it is a good idea to discourage play that involves sharing hair brushes. It is also a good practice to check your child's hair with a fine comb at least once a week and let the school know if there is a problem.

Should this become a serious issue we will then contact the Health Service for assistance from the public health nurse.
