**Monday 15th June**

- Build an obstacle course: If the weather is fine hopefully you can try this outside if not try and find a space at home where you can build your own obstacle course. You can use lots of objects from home like throwing/catching teddy bears, crawling under chairs, dribbling a ball, an egg and spoon race, skipping, walking on a line. These are some ideas to help you get started but we know you can come up with lots more.

**Tuesday 16th June**

- Water play: Revise the vocabulary from last weeks' water play. Collect a few objects from around the house that you think might float or sink in the water. Make a guess before you put the object into the water, then try it out and see if your guess was right.

### **Wednesday 17th June**

- Target Practice: Get an empty box at home (any box, cereal). Ask a grown up to help you cut out 3 different sized holes. Use a small ball, bean bag or teddy to try and hit the targets. Keep practicing to see can you hit the target!



### **Thursday 18th June**

- Build a fort: ask an adult where would be the best place to build a fort (garden, your bedroom, the play room). We have some pictures to help you come up with ideas.
