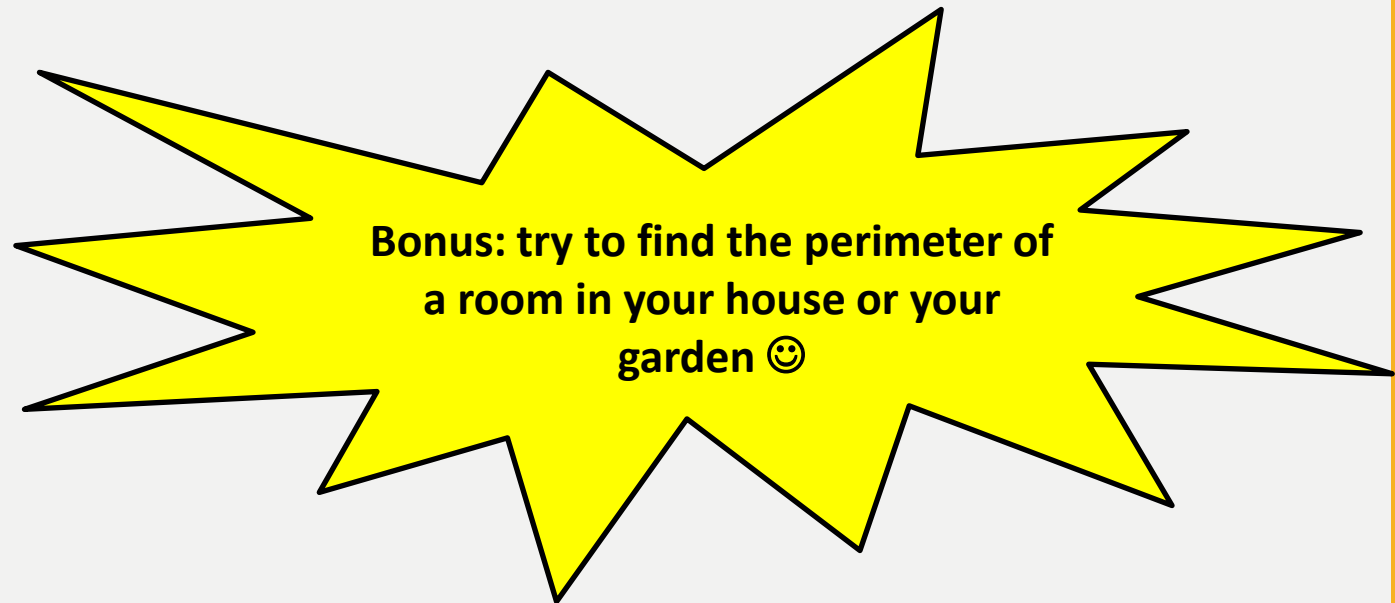
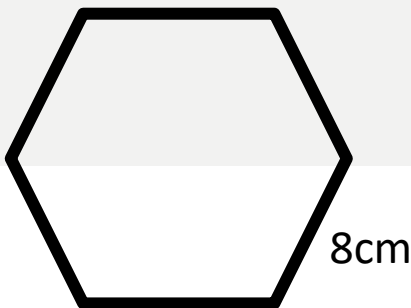

Remember: to find the perimeter of a shape, measure the length of each side and add them up

All the sides of this hexagon are equal in length. That means that there are 6 sides, each measuring 8cm. What is the perimeter?

$$8+8+8+8+8+8=48\text{cm}$$

OR

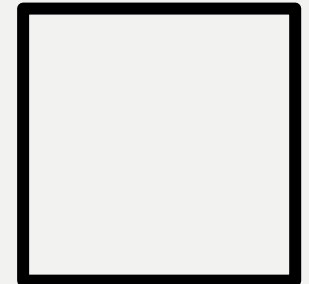
$$8 \times 6 = 48\text{cm}$$

2. The perimeter of a regular pentagon is 155m. **How long is each side?**
3. What is the length of each side of a regular hexagon if its perimeter is 210m?
