## Make your own board game

It would be really fun to make your own board game! Here is what you might need but it is up to you what you use!

- A large sheet of paper/card
- Pencil/colours
- Extra paper/card for challenge cards (optional)
- Little toys/coins/other items to move around your board game
- 1 die

How to make your own board game:

- 1. Place your paper/card on a table.
- 2. Mark out squares on the board game leading up to a target (eg. steps for Goldilocks to get to the three little bears' house.
- 3. Number the squares if you want.
- 4. Write down instructions next to a few squares (eg. move back 5 steps, move forward 4 steps, go back to start, pick up a challenge card). Most of the squares should have no instructions though.
- 5. If you want you can create a few challenge cards (eg. count in 4s up to 20, spell the colour of the top you are wearing, name as many animals as you can in 30 seconds, do 20 jumping jacks). You can invent any challenge you want which could be really fun. You don't need challenge cards though. You can write challenges on the board game if you want.
- 6. Decorate your board game with your colours.
- 7. As a family, lay some ground rules. Who gets to go first? Who gets to go next? What happens if you aren't able to perform the activity on the card? Can you ask for help? Can you skip turns?
- 8. Each player takes a turn rolling the die.
- 9. The first player to make it to the end wins.
