

You are invited to join us at Naas Race course for the Parkrun on January 12th 2019 at 9 am, where we will remember our dear friend and colleague, Kathy Casey-Byrne. Kathy was an avid runner and participated in Parkrun events herself, so it seems fitting to mark her first anniversary in this way.

Naas Parkrun is a fun, free event, organised by volunteers, for the benefit of all. It takes place on the ambulance track in Naas Racecourse every Saturday morning. The course is 5km long. So please come run, jog or walk with us on January 12th. Parking and toilet facilities are available in the Naas Racecourse car park on Tipper Road.

- This is a family event but children under the age of twelve must be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian while running the course.
- Dogs are not allowed at this event.
- Runners pushing buggies are welcome.
- Please run or walk on the right hand side to allow faster runners to overtake, if necessary.

If you want to be timed you must register for Parkrun at https://www.parkrun.ie/register/form/. All you have to do is fill in a few details, print your personalised barcode and bring it along on the day. Your result will be emailed to you later that same day. Or you may wish to cheer on the runners or bake cakes and pour tea at the finish line.

We will also need some volunteers to act as marshals at the event. Please contact the school if you are available to help in any way.
